

Moon Walk 2010 & Lakeview Museum: An Out-of-This-World Partnership



Moon Walk 2010, a community walking program organized by the Peoria Area Labor Management (PALM), is a proud partner in Lakeview's Interplanetary 5K Race/Walk. For the eighth consecutive year, Moon Walk will enlist tri-county individuals to participate in this community health promotion program. Moon Walk will have teams and members pooling their mileage to walk to the moon for a total of 238,700 miles. Racing against Peoria will be Quad Cities and Champaign/Urbana. The community to reach the moon and has the highest average miles per walker at the end of the race on June 11, 2010 will be declared the winner.

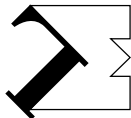

The **Lakeview Museum Community Solar System** was recognized by Guinness Book of Records from 1993-98, when the category was retired, as the largest such model in the world. The "Sun" is Lakeview's 36' diameter planetarium. The "Earth" is 4 inches across and 3/4 miles from the Sun. The dwarf planet, "Pluto", is 40 miles away and Eris is 70 miles away. (No, we're not going to run to Pluto!)

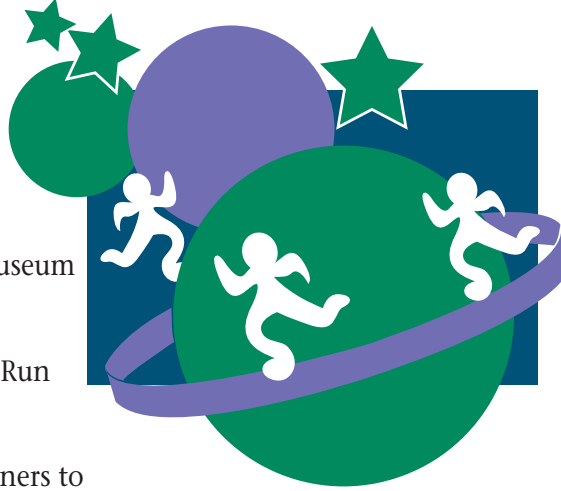
